It is \$100 minimum just for delivery.” Elinor says that homemade items are acceptable, and the menu is no longer posted; you do have to call Elinor. Jerry states that the prices offered are good and affordable, and they do not want any student to go hungry. He states that he is open to speaking to any student organizations. There are delegated dollars to donate to big events. \$10,000 is used for food insecurities to help students.
- c.* Center Discussion – Pack care provides free support for students. They fundraise basic needs and securities. They worked closely with the foundation and stated that they had 4,300 visits and 95 new people registered. They do take basic needs requests and also make donations.
