Dear fellow Choral Directors,

On behalf of CSU Pueblo, I am delighted to welcome you back this November for the **Southern Colorado High** School Honor Choir & Orchestra Festival, YES! Honor Orchestra is back! The event will be on our campus, Friday and Saturday, November 17-18, 2023, with the closing concert on Saturday evening at 7:00pm.

We are delighted to welcome Dr. Meredith Johnson as our clinician for the Honor Choir this year. I have had the pleasure of working with Dr. Johnson as a colleague and friend for more years than either of us will admit. She is supremely talented in working with voices in a myriad of contexts. She is Assistant Professor at the University of Southern Mississippi, teaching voice, pedagogy, and coaching for both opera and musical theatre. Dr. Johnson has served previously as a choir director and often conducts masterclasses and clinics for choirs and worship teams.

We will continue to offer placement in the Honor Choir by recommendation. Please nominate and help prepare your best quartet or double quartet of singers to participate. The students will be expected to have their choir parts learned and adequately prepared before arriving for the event. Due to space constraints, we will accept the first 150 students responding, with priority given to quartets from each school. It is our goal to have the choir as balanced as possible. Applications, accompanied by the fee of \$40 per student, will be considered in the order in which they are received. Registration fees are non-refundable. The fee includes the cost of a festival t-shirt for each participant and the Friday evening banquet meal. Late registrations will be accepted if space allows. If a student has to withdraw, you may offer that spot to another student, but please let us know. Individual schools will be responsible for transportation to and from the university, meals (other than the Friday banquet), and housing if needed. Students should provide their own black folder and should wear concert attire for the Saturday performance. If your school does not require a uniform, please have your participants wear all black.


